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HHS Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services Awards QSSI Additional National Level Repository Testing Work

Columbia, MD — Maryland-based QSSI was awarded an additional task order on the National Level Repository (NLR) Testing contract by the Department of Health & Human Services (HHS), Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). QSSI will perform ongoing Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health (HITECH) NLR maintenance release testing. QSSI will conduct testing on two annual maintenance releases per year, supporting both new functionality and system enhancements.

QSSI was awarded the NLR Testing contract in April 2010 to perform independent validation and performance testing. The goal of the NLR is to collect information on all eligible providers and hospitals, process and deliver incentive payments, prevent duplicate payments, and coordinate technical assistance and reporting. QSSI personnel manage and perform functional acceptance testing, performance and stress testing, end-to-end testing with other systems and contractors, as well as regression testing.
